As any good Boy Scout Leader knows, the patrol method is the heart of the Boy Scout Program. This patrol method is only as good as a motivated, trained youth can make it. Are your boys ready for the challenge of leadership? "Delivering the promise," means preparing your Scouts for their leadership roles in the troop and beyond. Preparation means training and training is NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training), the ultimate weeklong leadership training experience for boy leaders. During the summer of 2009, the Greater Alabama Council will offer two sessions of NYLT. Scouts will have the option to attend the one that fits their schedule the best.

**Qualifications:** Each Scout must be at least 13 years old and a First Class Scout. Each Scout must have the approval of his Scoutmaster and furnish a Class 2 medical form.

The courses are limited to 48 participants each so get your registration information and deposits in today! Once the courses reach 48 participants a waiting list will be established.

**Cost:** The cost of the course is \$205.00. A \$50.00 deposit and the registration form are due at any GAC Service Center by April 1, 2009. Full payment is due by May 15, 2009 for Session 1 or June 15, 2009 for Session 2. A \$35.00 late fee will be added to the original cost of the course after these dates.
