

Trainer's EDGE is BSA's new trainer development course designed to help Scouters put into practice the EDGE training model (**E**xplain, **D**emonstrate **G**uide & **E**nable) and gain self-confidence through hands-on training experiences. This course replaces the Trainer Development Conference (TDC).

Trainer's EDGE brings to life the EDGE model taught in Troop Leadership Training, Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Specific Training, National Youth Leadership Training, and Wood Badge. Participants are given opportunity to prepare and practice a training session of their choice, using materials, equipment, and/or props that they bring with them to the course.
